WHY

Whatever target surface you wrap, you should always assume that it is contaminated and needs to be cleaned.

WHAT FOR?

- · To remove traces of grease, of adhesive and any dust
- · To make film installation easier
- · To save time during the installation
- · To ensure good adhesion

ADVICE FOR FULL WRAPS

Preparing an entire vehicle for a full wrap requires at least one hour of cleaning. The cleaning should be done with great care paying particular attention to difficult areas such as underseal, bumpers and headlights. A thorough cleaning process will prevent the risk of the film lifting off.

CLEANING ALL TYPES OF SURFACES

Use Final Cleaner

HEXIS recommend using Final Cleaner to clean all types of substrates and in particular vehicle bodies, shop windows and sign boards.

First vaporise Final Cleaner on the vehicle body, then wipe with a clean microfibre cloth until dry so as not to leave any traces.

TIP

Use a separate microfibre cloth for each cleaning product

AND FOR A COMPLETE CLEAN

Use Remover + Precleaner beforehand

If the vehicle body is heavily soiled (traces of petrol, tar, adhesives...) do not hesitate to use our other cleaning liquids before the final clean: Remover and Precleaner.

The vehicle body must be cleaned with a microfibre cloth: clean and dry for Remover and moistened for Precleaner.
